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38	STATEMENT OF FACT
40	The purpose of this amendment is to increase the proportion of the Maine Children's Trust Fund money that is granted to
42	community prevention programs, either through increased income or through reduced administrative costs, or both. The Board of the
44	Maine Children's Trust Fund is required to conduct a study in cooperation with a statewide public foundation created to attract

and manage charitable funds, such as the Maine Community
Foundation, Inc., to determine whether some form of subordinate or contractual or other relationship would achieve these goals
and to report its recommendations to the Joint Standing Committee on Human Resources and the Office of the Executive Director of
the Legislative Council no later than January 15, 1991.
