22	facilitate the management, administration and distribution of fund money, the board shall conduct a study of the potential
24	positive and negative consequences of entering into a contract with a statewide public foundation created to attract and manage
26	charitable funds and to distribute the income to Maine nonprofit organizations to help solve community problems and enhance the
28	quality of life in the State. The board shall report its finding to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having
30	jurisdiction over human resource matters no later than January 15, 1991, along with its recommendations for any legislative
32	action based on these findings.'
34	STATEMENT OF FACT
36	The purpose of this amendment is to increase the proportion
38	of the Maine Children's Trust Fund money that is granted to community prevention programs, either through increased income or
40	through reduced administrative costs, or both. The board is required to conduct a study in cooperation with a statewide
42	public foundation created to attract and manage charitable funds, such as the Maine Community Foundation, Inc., to determine
