COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 958, L.D. 2422, Bill, "An Act to Allow Certain School Secretaries to Elect Not to Be Members of the Maine State Retirement System"

Amend the bill by striking everything after the enacting clause and before the statement of fact and inserting in its place the following:

'PL 1989, c. 550, §3 is amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read:

Notwithstanding other provisions of this section, employees of public schools on June 30, 1989, who were employed as school secretaries and who, due to error or oversight, were not members of the Maine State Retirement System on June 30, 1989, or for any period of time prior to that date, may elect not to be members by giving written notice to the Executive Director of the Maine State Retirement System on or before January 1, 1991. This election is irrevocable.

FISCAL NOTE

This bill may reduce the State's contributions to teachers' retirement by an insignificant amount.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment relocates the text of the original bill, eliminates the provision that the error or oversight be due to the employer and adds a fiscal note.
