24	Notwithstanding other provisions of this section, employees of public schools on June 30, 1989, who were employed as school
26	secretaries and who, due to error or oversight, were not members of the Maine State Retirement System on June 30, 1989, or for any
28	period of time prior to that date, may elect not to be members by giving written notice to the Executive Director of the Maine
30	<u>State Retirement System on or before January 1, 1991. This election is irrevocable.</u>
