COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1758, L.D. 2423, Bill, "An Act to Clarify the Laws on Manslaughter in the Workplace"

Amend the bill in paragraph C in subparagraph (1) in the last line (page 1, line 31 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "and" and inserting in its place the following: 'or'

Further amend the bill in paragraph C in subparagraph (2) in the first line (page 1, line 33 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "responding to" the following: 'or acting at'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment clarifies the language in the original bill to carry out the intent to exempt from the workplace manslaughter law all those performing public functions for minimal compensation or as volunteers. It also exempts public employees when they are responding to or acting at a life-threatening situation if forced to make decisions regarding saving the life of a human being.
