SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 962, L.D. 2429, "Resolve, to Direct the Department of Human Services to Develop a Proposal to Adequately Address the Housing Needs of Aid to Families with Dependent Children Recipients"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of the 2nd paragraph after the title (page 1, lines 22 to 25 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

'Further amend the resolve in subsection 2 in the last line (page 1, line 21 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "Program;" and inserting in its place the following: 'Program; and"

Further amend the resolve in subsection 3 in the last line (page 1, line 25 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "; and" and inserting in its place the following: 'and report those recommendations to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over human resource matters and the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over appropriations and financial affairs in the First Regular Session of the 115th Legislature; and be it further

Further amend the resolve in section 1 by striking out all of subsection 4 (page 1, lines 27 to 31 in L.D.).'

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of section 2 (page 1, lines 30 to 49 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 2. Appropriation. Resolved: That the following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this resolve.
