COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to S.P. 962, L.D. 2429, "Resolve, to Direct the Department of Human Services to Develop a Proposal to Adequately Address the Housing Needs of Aid to Families with Dependent Children Recipients"

Amend the resolve in the first paragraph after the preamble in the first line (page 1, line 9 in L.D.) by inserting at the beginning the following: 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend the resolve in subsection 4 in the 3rd line (page 1, line 29 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "the First" and inserting in its place the following: 'the Joint Standing Committee on Human Resources of the First'

Further amend the resolve by inserting before the statement of fact the following:

'Sec. 2. Appropriation. Resolved: That the following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this resolve.
