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Sec. 1. Commission reauthorized; membership. Resolved: That
the Commission to Evaluate the Adequacy of the Aid to Families
with Dependent Children Need and Payment Standards established by
Public Law 1989, chapter 501, Part S, is reauthorized. The
current members of the commission continue in office and the
duties of the commission remain as defined in chapter 501; and be
it further
Sec. 2. Meetings. Resolved: That the chair of the commission
shall call a meeting of the commission by August 15, 1990. The
commission is authorized to meet up to 6 times; and be it further
Sec. 3. Report. Resolved: That the commission shall submit
its report, together with any necessary implementing legislation,
to the First Regular Session of the 115th Legislature and to the
Office of the Executive Director of the Legislative Council by
February 15, 1991; and be it further
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Sec. 4. Staff assistance. Resolved: That the Department of Human
Services shall provide sufficient staff assistance to the
commission to carry out its duties; and be it further
Sec. 5. Reimbursement. Resolved: That the members of the
commission who are Legislators are entitled to receive the
legislative per diem, as defined in the Maine Revised Statutes,
Title 3, section 2, for days of attendance at commission
meetings. All members of the commission who are not state
employees shall are entitled to expenses, as defined in the Maine
Revised Statutes, Title 5, section 12002, upon application to the
Executive Director of the Legislative Council for those expenses;

Sec. 6. Appropriation. Resolved: That the following funds are
appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of
