	Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not
2 ,	become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

6	Whereas, most, but not all, of the funds needed to construct a memorial for slain law enforcement officers have been raised through solicitation efforts; and
8	Whereas, the time allowed for solicitation of funds may
10	expire before sufficient funds are raised; and
12	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of
14	Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and
.16	safety; now, therefore,
18	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
20	P&SL 1989, c. 47, §1, first sentence is amended to read:
22	For ene-year <u>18 months</u> following the effective date of this Act, the prohibition on solicitation under the Maine Revised
24	Statutes, Title 25, section 3702, shall does not apply to persons authorized under section 2 of this Act to solicit funds for the
26	payment of or to pay for any obligations incurred in the completion, erection and maintenance of one memorial to
28	commemorate law enforcement officers slain in the line of duty, to be erected at a location selected by the Maine Chiefs of
