HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1771, L.D. 2441, Bill, "An Act to Establish Municipal Cost Components for Services to be Rendered in Fiscal Year 1990-91"

Amend the amendment by inserting after the first paragraph after the title the following:

Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §1602, sub-§4, ¶B-1 is enacted to read:

B-1. Beginning in fiscal year 1990-91, the district-wide mill rate may include a state cost allocation charge, not to exceed 15% of the total state agency reimbursements for direct services rendered. Funds from this charge must be used to reimburse the General Fund for general department-wide functions such as accounting, personnel administration and supervision.

Further amend the amendment in section 1 by striking out all of the 18th line (page 1, line 43 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

Total State Agencies - Direct Services	\$7,731,999
State CAP charge - 13%	1,005,160
Total State Agencies	\$8,737,159'

Further amend the amendment in section 1 in the 16th line from the end (page 2, line 9 in amendment) by striking out the following: "\$10,150,859" and inserting in its place the following: '\$11,156,019'

Further amend the amendment in section 1 under the caption "COMPUTATION OF ASSESSMENT" by striking out all of the first line (page 2, line 13 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

2 'Requirements \$11,156,019'

4 Further amend the amendment in section 1 under the caption
"COMPUTATION OF ASSESSMENT" by striking out all of the
6 last line (page 2, line 31 in amendment) and inserting in its
place the following:

10 'TAX ASSESSMENT \$10,058,061'

12 Further amend the amendment by inserting after section 1 the
following:

14 'Further amend the bill by renumbering the sections to read
consecutively.'

18 Further amend the amendment by renumbering the sections to
read consecutively.

20 Further amend the amendment by striking out all of the
fiscal note (page 2, lines 36 to 40 in amendment) and inserting
22 in its place the following:

26 **FISCAL NOTE**

28 There will be increased revenue of \$1,005,160 to the General
Fund as a result of this legislation because all General Fund
30 expenditures for other than direct services will be reimbursed
through the municipal cost component.'

34 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

36 This amendment makes changes to the municipal cost component
to allow the General Fund to be reimbursed for expenditures
38 currently being made for statewide functions.
