SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1776, L.D. 2444, Bill, "An Act to Make Supplemental Allocations from the Highway Fund for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1990, and June 30, 1991"

Amend the amendment by inserting after Part E the following:

PART F

29 MRSA §1312, sub-§9, as repealed and replaced by PL 1971, c. 547, is amended to read:


9. Payment for tests. Persons authorized to take specimens of blood at the direction of a law enforcement officer and persons authorized to perform chemical blood-alcohol tests of specimens by analysis of blood or breath shall must be paid from the General Highway Fund.'

FISCAL NOTE

Funds for this program are included in the Highway Fund Budget.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment contains language identical to that in L.D. 2041, previously enacted relating to the cost of blood-alcohol tests, but gives that language an immediate effective date.
