18	enacting clause the following:
20	'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted
22	as emergencies; and
24	Whereas, Private and Special Law 1987, chapter 117, provided that, upon submission to the voters of Greenville for their
26	approval at the next regular municipal election after its effective date, a parcel of land in Cove Point Township would be
28	annexed to the Town of Greenville; and
30	Whereas, the voters of Greenville voted on the annexation at a special town meeting held on November 8, 1988; and
32	Whereas, questions have been raised about the efficacy of
34	the November 8, 1988 special town meeting to satisfy the condition of approval at the next regular municipal election; and
36	Whereas, the Legislature finds that the purpose of the
38	referendum approval required by the law was fulfilled; and
40	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts
42	create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately
44	necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,'
