**Resolve, Authorizing Rommy Haines to Present a Claim for 3rd-party Damages to a Board of Arbitration a 2nd Time.**

---

(AFTER DEADLINE)



2 **Rommy Haines; authorized to present claim to Board of Arbitration**  
3 **2nd time. Resolved:** That, notwithstanding any law or common law  
4 to the contrary, Rommy Haines, who claims to be entitled to  
5 3rd-party damages pursuant to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title  
6 38, section 551, because of damages suffered as a result of an  
7 oil discharge, and further claims, due to extenuating  
8 circumstances, to have been wronged by the decision of a Board of  
9 Arbitration, is authorized to present his claim to a Board of  
10 Arbitration a 2nd time.

11 This claim must be presented to a Board of Arbitration  
12 within one year of the passage of this resolve. The procedure  
13 for bringing the claim before a Board of Arbitration and  
14 determining damages must be in accordance with state law.

15 Any recovery that is finally adjudged to be payable must be  
16 offset by the sum of \$78,000, the amount awarded by the original  
17 Board of Arbitration and paid to the credit of Rommy Haines.
