SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 1000, L.D. 2472, "Resolve, to Encourage the Study of the Nation's Founding and Related Documents by Maine Students"

Amend the resolve in section 5 in the 2nd line (page 2, line 5 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "Educational and Cultural Services" and inserting in its place the following: 'Education'

Further amend the resolve in section 6 in the 2nd line (page 2, line 17 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "Educational and Cultural Services" and inserting in its place the following: 'Education'

Further amend the resolve by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

**'FISCAL NOTE**

The Department of Education will incur some minor additional administrative costs to implement this resolve. These costs can be absorbed within existing budgeted resources. However, this resolve may result in increased expenditures by local school units. Although those additional expenditures are not the result of a state mandate, the department would incur additional subsidy costs beginning in fiscal year 1992-93. Any expected increase in subsidy costs would not be significant.'

**STATEMENT OF FACT**

This amendment adds a fiscal note to the resolve and corrects references to the Department of Education.
