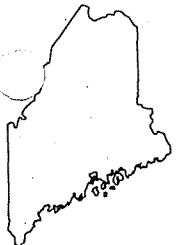

An Act to Allow the Maine Health Care Finance Commission to Make Individual Hospital Development Account Interim Adjustments.

(AFTER DEADLINE)



Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

PL 1989, c. 588, Pt. A, §59, 2nd ¶ is amended to read:

The commission shall administer the hospital care financing system established by the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 22, chapter 107, as those provisions of law existed prior to the effective date of this Act, with respect to all hospital payment years beginning before October 1, 1990, except that the commission may, upon application by a hospital, grant interim adjustments to financial requirements for payment years beginning on or after October 1, 1989, and before October 1, 1990, to reflect any costs resulting from projects that meet the requirements of Title 22, former section 396-K, subsection 3, paragraph E, as it existed prior to its repeal by section 38 of this Act. The continuing authority provided by this section shall-~~extend~~ extends to the determination and enforcement of compliance with revenue limits for those earlier payment years and to the settlement of payments and adjustments of overcharges and undercharges for those years, in proceedings that may be commenced after the close of those years. Nothing in this Act may be construed to limit the authority of the commission to enforce compliance with or seek penalties for violation of any provision of Title 22, chapter 107, that was in effect at the time of the act, event or failure to act with respect to which enforcement action is taken or penalties are sought.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill allows the Maine Health Care Finance Commission to make interim adjustments to financial requirements for projects under the Hospital Development Account.
