Sec. 1. P&SL 1937, c. 80, $\S4$, as repealed and replaced by P&SL 1987, c. 34, $\S1$, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

Sec. 4. Territorial limits; name; purposes. The City of Presque Isle and the inhabitants and territory within that city, which is bounded and described as follows: on the north by the corporate boundary of the City of Presque Isle (also being the south line of the City of Caribou); on the east by the corporate boundary of the City of Presque Isle (also being the west lines of the Town of Easton and the Town of Fort Fairfield) on the south by the corporate boundary of the City of Presque Isle (also being the north line of the Town of Westfield); and on the west by the corporate boundary of the City of Presque Isle (also being the east lines of the Town of Chapman, the Town of Mapleton and the Town of Washburn) is hereby created a body politic and corporate by the name of Presque Isle Sewer District for the purpose of providing in that district a system of public sewage and drainage for the comfort, convenience and health of the inhabitants of the district, with all the rights, privileges and immunities incident to similar corporations.

Sec. 2. P&SL 1941, c. 67, §1, as amended by P&SL 1987, c. 34, \S^2 , is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

Sec. 1. Territorial limits; name; purposes. The City of Presque 28 Isle and the inhabitants and territory within that city, which is bounded and described as follows: on the north by the corporate 30 boundary of the City of Presque Isle (also being the south line 32 of the City of Caribou); on the east by the corporate boundary of the City of Presque Isle (also being the west lines of the Town 34 of Easton and the Town of Fort Fairfield) on the south by the corporate boundary of the City of Presque Isle (also being the north line of the Town of Westfield); and on the west by the 36 corporate boundary of the City of Presque Isle (also being the 38 east lines of the Town of Chapman, the Town of Mapleton and the Town of Washburn) is hereby created a body politic and corporate by the name of Presque Isle Water District for the purpose of 40 supplying inhabitants of that district with pure water for 42 domestic, sanitary, commercial and municipal purposes.

Sec. 3. Referendum; effective date. This Act must be submitted to the legal voters of the districts and the legal voters of the territory to be added to the sewer and water districts at a special election or elections to be called and held for that purpose. The elections must be called by the municipal officers of the City of Presque Isle and must be held at the regular voting places. The dates of the elections must be determined by the municipal officers, but the first election in the district

may not be later than December 1, 1990. These special elections 2 must be called, advertised and conducted according to the law relating to municipal elections; except that the board of 4 registration is not required to prepare nor the city clerk to post a new list of voters and for this purpose the board of 6 registration shall be in session on the 3 secular days next preceding the elections, the first and 2nd days to be devoted to 8 registration of voters and the last day to enable the board to verify the corrections of the lists and to complete and close up 10 its records of the session. The city clerk shall reduce the subject matter of this Act to the following questions:

(1) "Shall the boundaries of the Presque Isle Sewer District be extended?"

(2) "Shall the boundaries of the Presque Isle Water District be extended?"

The voters shall indicate by a cross (X) or check mark (\checkmark) 20 placed against the word "Yes" or "No" their opinion of the same.

22 Section 1 of this Act takes effect for all purposes immediately upon the acceptance of the question of extension of 24 the sewer district boundaries by a majority of the legal voters of the sewer district and a majority of the legal voters of the 26 territory to be added to the sewer district, voting at the elections, but only if the total number of votes cast for and 28 against the acceptance of this Act in the special elections equals or exceeds 10% of the registered voters of the district 30 and 10% of the registered voters of the territory to be added to the district, but failure of approval by the necessary percentage 32 of voters does not prevent subsequent elections.

34 Section 2 of this Act takes effect for all purposes immediately upon the acceptance of the question of extension of 36 the water district boundaries by a majority of the legal voters of the water district and a majority of the legal voters of the 38 territory to be added to the water district, voting at the elections, but only if the total number of votes cast for and 40 against the acceptance of this Act in the special elections equals or exceeds 10% of the registered voters of the district 42 and 10% of the registered voters of the territory to be added to the district, but failure of approval by the necessary percentage 44 of voters does not prevent subsequent elections.

The results of the elections must be declared by the municipal officers of the city and due certificates thereof must
be filed by the city clerk with the Secretary of State.
