#### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND NINETY

An Act to Encourage the Development of Programs of Assistance to Students Seeking Postsecondary Education.



#### Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

PL 1989, c. 559, §12, sub-§7, as enacted by PL 1989, c. 698, §74, is amended to read:

Additional issues; continuation of advisory committee. 7. Following submission of the report to the Joint Standing Committee on Education, the Governor and the Finance Authority of Maine described in subsection 4, the transition committee established in this section shall continue in existence until July 1, 1990. The committee shall continue to act in an advisory capacity and shall report with the Maine Education Assistance Board to the Joint Standing Committee on Education on the following matters: the Maine Educational Loan Authority supplemental loan program, the loan of last resort program, the student financial assistance counseling and outreach program, and ether-financial-assistance-programs-which-may-be-implemented-er expanded -- in -- the -- future -- such -- as the Student Educational Enhancement Deposit Plan, the Maine Choice Program, the Advanced Study for Educators Program and the Trio Program. The transition advisory committee and the Maine Education Assistance Board shall work jointly on the foregoing programs. The transition advisory committee and the Maine Education Assistance Board jointly may request staff assistance from the Legislative Council and shall report to the Joint Standing Committee on Education by December July 1, 1990. Funds remaining in the committee's account must be carried over to fiscal year 1990-91 to accomplish that task.
