COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A" to S.P. 1003, L.D. 2491, "Resolve, to Authorize the Director of the Bureau of Public Lands to Sell a Parcel of Land to the Warren Sanitary District"

Amend the resolve in the title in the first line by striking out the following: "Lands" and inserting in its place the following: 'Improvements'

Further amend the resolve in the first paragraph after the title in the first line (page 1, line 1 in resolve) by striking out the following: "Lands" and inserting in its place the following: 'Improvements'

Further amend the resolve by inserting before the statement of fact the following:

'FISCAL NOTE

The sale of the parcel of land and easements to the Warren Sanitary District will result in additional General Fund revenue equal to the appraised value. The appraised value has not yet been established.

The cost of the land and easements will be amortized through user fees. Approximately 60% of these fees will be paid by the Warren State Prison. Funding has already been provided by General Fund appropriation for the fees to be assessed in fiscal year 1990-91.'

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This amendment clarifies that the resolve authorizes the Bureau of Public Improvements rather than the Bureau of Public Lands to sell a parcel of land to the Warren Sanitary District and adds a fiscal note.
