16	Amend the bill by by inserting after section 3 the following:
18	'Sec. 4. 12 MRSA §7365, sub-§6-A is enacted to read:
20	6-A. Sale of business; allocations. When a licensed
22	whitewater outfitter's business is sold, the selling outfitter's allocations or portions of the allocations subject to the sale
66	must be returned to the department. On application to the
24	department, allocations may be reissued to the purchaser,
26	provided that the purchaser meets the licensing and allocation
26	requirements of the department and pays the license and allocation fees. Profit on the return and reissuance of any
28	allocations is prohibited, but nothing in this subchapter
	prohibits a profit on the sale of any of the assets of a
30	business. The allocations are not assets of a business. The department may require an affidavit from the selling outfitter or
32	purchaser, or both, to aid in enforcement of this provision.
	Allocations or portions of the allocations may be transferred,
34	pursuant to this chapter, from a selling outfitter to one or more purchasers only if the selling outfitter's allocations or
36	portions of the allocations subject to the sale are returned to
	the department.'

40	Further amend the bill by renumbering the sections to read consecutively.
