STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND NINETY

An Act to Extend the Sunset of Special Seasonal Liquor Stores.

(AFTER DEADLINE)

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

28-A MRSA §456, sub-§3, as amended by PL 1989, c. 492 and c. 600, Pt. A, §§17 and 18, is further amended to read:

3. Sunset. This section is repealed on September-30,-1990 January 15, 1991, before which time the commission shall evaluate the effectiveness of this section and make a written report to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over legal affairs no later than January-31,--1990 December 31, 1990.

FISCAL NOTE

Enactment of this legislation will result in an increase to General Fund revenues in the amount of \$25,000 for fiscal year 1990-91.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill extends the sunset of special seasonal agency liquor stores to allow the State Liquor Commission to review the efficacy of the stores and to provide the Joint Standing Committee on Legal Affairs with an opportunity to determine whether the special seasonal agency stores should be continued.

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
