HOUSE AMENDMENT "C" to H.P. 1842, L.D. 2513, Bill, "An Act to Establish the Rural Medical Access Program and the 5-year Medical Liability Demonstration Project and to Revise the Discovery Rule without Imposing Caps on Damages and the Rules Regarding Collateral Sources"

Amend the bill in section 3 in that part designated "§2906." by inserting at the end the following:

'8. Repeal. This section is repealed on July 1st of the first policy year beginning on or after July 1, 1992, for which the superintendent determines that the assessment to be made pursuant to Title 24-A, section 6305 is less than \$250,000.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment repeals the collateral source provisions of the bill on July 1, 1992, or in a later year if the superintendent determines that the 12-month saving from the collateral source and demonstration project provisions are less than \$250,000. The determination of the savings is made for purposes of the assessment for the Rural Medical Access program.
