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SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 847, "JOINT RESOLUTION  
MEMORIALIZING THE PRESIDENT AND THE CONGRESS OF THE UNITED STATES  
TO TAKE ACTION TO PREVENT THE CLOSING OF THE DEPARTMENT OF  
VETERANS AFFAIRS REGIONAL OFFICE AT TOGUS, MAINE"

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Amend the resolution in the 2nd paragraph in the 2nd line by  
striking out the following: "proposed to consolidate the  
central" and inserting in its place the following: 'a plan to  
consolidate the regional'

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Further amend the resolution by inserting after the 4th  
paragraph the following:

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'WHEREAS, such a consolidation may result in fewer  
inpatient and outpatient visits to the Togus medical facility,  
thus resulting in a further reduction of operating funds and  
services; and'

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Further amend the resolution in the 5th paragraph in the  
first line by inserting after the word "positions" the  
following: 'and services'

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Further amend the resolution in the 6th paragraph in the 4th  
line by striking out the following: "cancel this ill-advised"  
and inserting in its place the following: 'abandon any such'


