HOUSE AMENDMENT "*A*" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1,
L.D. 1, Bill, "An Act to Codify the Rules of Maine"

Amend the amendment in section 2 in subsection 9 by striking
out all of paragraph C (page 2, lines 42 to 46 in amendment) and
inserting in its place the following:

'C. Any publication of a rule or rules that is not
certified by the Secretary of State:

(1) May neither state nor imply that the publication is
an official copy of the rules; and

(2) Must state in a conspicuous location where the
Secretary of State's certified copy is located.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment eliminates the requirement that publications
of a rule or rules that are not certified by the Secretary of
State must bear a conspicuous notice that they are not
certified. That requirement is replaced by 2 provisions. The
publication:

1. May neither state nor imply that it is certified; and
2. Must conspicuously identify the location of the
Secretary of State's certified copy.
