An Act to Clarify the Waste Transfer Station Setback Requirements.

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## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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38 MRSA §1310-N, sub-§2-C, as affected by PL 1989, c. 890, 4 Pt. A, §40, and amended by Pt. B, §242, is further amended to read:

2-C. Proximity to residential areas. The department may
8 not issue a license for a municipal solid waste transfer station
in which the handling site will be located within 250 feet of any
10 residential property boundary.

## STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill amends the law concerning solid waste transfer 16 stations so that the setback applies to any residential property boundary.
