16	Amend the bill in that part designated "\$873." in subsection 2 in the last 2 lines (page 1, lines 44 and 45 in L.D.) by
18	striking out the following: 'who is a resident of Franklin County'
20	Further amend the bill by striking out all those parts designated "§874.", "§875." and "§876." and inserting in their
22	place the following:
24	'§874. Budget procedures
26	1. Budget procedures. The Franklin County commissioners shall submit itemized finance estimates in the form of a budget
28	to the advisory committee no later than 60 days before the end of the county's fiscal year.
30	2. Budget review process. The advisory committee shall
32	review the itemized estimated budget prepared by the county commissioners, together with any supplementary material prepared
34	by the head of each county department or provided by any independent board or institution or another governmental agency.
36	The advisory committee shall prepare a proposed budget and may increase, decrease or alter the estimated budget as long as:

40	A. The advisory committee enters into its minutes are explanation for any suggested change in the estimated
42	expenditures and revenues as initially presented by the county commissioners; and

	3. Public hearing. The advisory committee shall hold a
2	public hearing in the county on the proposed budget before the
	end of the county's fiscal year and before the final adoption of
4	the budget. Notice of the hearing must be given in all
_	newspapers of general circulation within the county at least 10
6	days before the hearing. Written notice and a copy of the
8	proposed budget must be sent by mail, or delivered in person, to
0	the clerk of each municipality in the county. The municipal clerk shall notify the municipal officials of the proposed budget.
10	Clerk shall notity the manicipal officials of the proposed budget.
10	4. Finality of budget. After the public hearing is
12	completed, the advisory committee shall adopt a final budget and
	transmit that budget to the county commissioners. The county
14	commissioners may not further increase, decrease, alter or revise
	the budget adopted by the advisory committee, except by unanimous
16	vote of the county commissioners. If the adopted budget is
	changed by the county commissioners, the advisory committee may
18	reject that change by a 2/3 vote of its membership. Those
	actions are final and are not subject to further action by either
20	the county commissioners or the advisory committee.
22	§875. Filing of final budget
24	A copy of the final budget must be filed with the State
	Auditor on forms approved by the Department of Audit. The State
26	Auditor shall retain the forms for 3 years.
28	§876. Repeal
30	This article is repealed on April 30, 1993, unless continued
_	by act of the Legislature upon the review and recommendation of
32	the joint standing committee of the Legislature having
	jurisdiction over state and local government matters.'
