COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 16, L.D. 19, Bill, "An Act to Require Proof of Insurance in Order to Register an Automobile"

Amend the bill by striking the title and substituting the following:

'An Act to Remove the Sunset on the Financial Responsibility Laws'

Further amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the statement of fact and inserting in its place the following:

'29 MRSA §780, sub-§8, as amended by PL 1989, c. 824, §4, is repealed.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment deletes the requirement of showing proof of insurance in order to register a motor vehicle. It also repeals the sunset provision in the financial responsibility laws.
