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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD  
NINETEEN HUNDRED AND NINETY

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An Act to Expand the Lemon Law to Include Recreational Vehicles.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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10 MRSA §1161, sub-§3, as amended by PL 1987, c. 359, §2, is  
4 further amended to read:

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3. **Motor vehicle.** "Motor vehicle" means any motor driven  
vehicle, including any recreational vehicle, designed for the  
8 conveyance of passengers or property on the public highways,  
which that is sold or leased in this State, except that the term  
10 "motor vehicle" does not include any commercial vehicle with a  
gross vehicle weight of 8,500 pounds or more.

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### STATEMENT OF FACT

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This bill adds recreational vehicles to the vehicles covered  
18 under the Maine Lemon Law.

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
