Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

23 MRSA §1403 is enacted to read:

§1403. Removal of tires

A person may not drop, throw away or allow to remain on any public way any blown-out tire or part of any blown-out tire. A person who violates this section commits a civil violation and is subject to a forfeiture of not more than \$500.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill requires that any person who blows out a tire on a public way must pick up the pieces. The bill makes it a civil violation to leave blown-out tires on public ways.
