An Act to Increase the Property Tax Exemption for Disabled Veterans.



## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

6	D-1. The estates up to the just value of $$47,500 $95,000$ ,
8	having a taxable situs in the place of residence, for specially adapted housing units, of veterans who served in
10	the Armed Forces of the United States during any federally recognized war period and who are paraplegic veterans, so-called, within the meaning of the United States Code,
12	Title 38, Chapter 21, Section 801, and who received a grant from the United States Government for the specially adapted
14	housing, or of the unremarried widows of the veterans. The exemption provided in this paragraph shall-apply applies to
16	the property of the veteran including property held in joint tenancy with that veteran's spouse.
