An Act to Require Proof of Insurance to Register a Motor Vehicle.

---



Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

29 MRSA §109-A is enacted to read:

§109-A. Proof of insurance; automobile

A person may not register an automobile under this Title unless proof of automobile insurance for that automobile is presented at the time of registration.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill requires that, in order to register an automobile, a person must present proof of automobile insurance.
