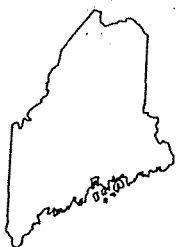

**An Act to Extend the Reporting Deadline of the Commission to
Implement the Computerization of Criminal History Record Information.**

(EMERGENCY)



Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the Commission to Implement the Computerization of Criminal History Record Information requires additional time to oversee the development and implementation of an effective computerized system; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. P&SL 1985, c. 135, §4, last sentence, as affected by PL 1989, c. 878, Pt. A, §§147 and 148, is amended to read:

The commission shall present its final report and recommendations, together with any recommended legislation, to the First Regular Session of the 115th 116th Legislature by March 1, 1991 1993.

Sec. 2. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act takes effect when approved.

STATEMENT OF FACT
