18	STATEMENT OF FACT
20	Currently, members of the Maine State Retirement System mus have 15 years of creditable service before they are eligible to
22	purchase service credit for up to 4 years service in the arme forces.
24	This bill allows members who retired from the armed force
26	to purchase credit for up to 4 years of military servic regardless of the amount of their state service.
