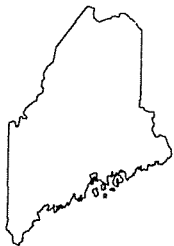

**An Act to Remove Residency Restrictions from the Office of Registrar
of Voters.**



Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

4 21-A MRSA §101, sub-§1, as enacted by PL 1985, c. 161, §6,
is amended to read:

6 1. **Qualifications.** The registrar must be a citizen of the
United States, ~~a resident of the municipality~~ and at least 18
8 years of age. He The registrar may not hold or be a candidate
for any state or county office, or hold membership on any party
