42	STATEMENT OF FACT
42	The original bill appropriated funds for a particular
44	program for chemically dependent women. The amendment replaces the bill and directs the Office of Substance Abuse to develop a
46	needs assessment for chemically dependent women, seek federal
48	demonstration project grants and assist private agencies to seek grants for projects for chemically dependent women.
50	This amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
