SENATE AMENDMENT " A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 42,  
L.D. 66, "RESOLUTION, Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution  
of Maine to Provide State Funding of any Mandate Imposed on  
Municipalities"

Amend the amendment in section 21 in subsection 1 in  
paragraph D in subparagraph (3) in the 3rd line (page 2, line 25  
in amendment) by striking out the following: "tort liability  
proceedings" and inserting in its place the following: 'under the  
Maine Tort Claims Act'

Further amend the amendment in section 21 in subsection 2 by  
striking out all of paragraph B and inserting in its place the  
following:

'B. Expands or amends laws relating to traffic infractions,  
criminal laws or laws imposing civil violations or  
penalties.'

Further amend the amendment in section 21 in subsection 2 in  
paragraph D (page 2, line 52 in amendment) by striking out the  
following: "or"

Further amend the amendment in section 21 in subsection 2 in  
paragraph E in the last line (page 3, line 4 in amendment) by  
striking out the following: "law." and inserting in its place the  
following: 'law.'

Further amend the amendment in section 21 in subsection 2 by  
inserting at the end the following:

P. of S.

2 'F. Enacts laws or adopts rules to implement requirements  
of this Constitution; or

4 G. Enacts laws or adopts rules to implement the Maine Human  
Rights Act.'

**STATEMENT OF FACT**

10 This amendment amends the committee amendment to clarify  
12 that the State does not have the responsibility of funding  
14 mandates that expand or amend laws relating to traffic  
16 infractions or laws imposing civil violations or penalties. It  
also excludes laws or rules adopted to implement the Constitution  
of Maine and the Maine Human Rights Act and mandates resulting  
from judgments under the Maine Tort Claims Act.
