HOUSE AMENDMENT "C" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "B" to S.P. 42,  
L.D. 66, "RESOLUTION, Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution  
of Maine to Provide State Funding of any Mandate Imposed on  
Municipalities"

Amend the amendment in section 21 in the first paragraph in  
the 7th and 8th lines from the end (page 1, lines 43 and 44 in  
amendment) by striking out the following: "pertains to wages,  
salaries or benefits for state and local public employees;" and  
inserting in its place the following: 'increases the minimum  
wage;'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment removes the provision that provides that  
legislation pertaining to wages, salaries or benefits for public  
employees are not mandates that are required to be funded by the  
State and specifies that minimum wage increases are not required  
to be funded.
