HOUSE AMENDMENT "D" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "B" to S.P. 42, L.D.

If approved by the voters, this constitutional requirement to fund the municipal cost of state mandates would increase the cost to the State of implementing many laws and rules. The Legislative Office of Fiscal and Program Review also will require 2 additional staff and resources to assess the municipal fiscal impact of each proposed law. The estimated cost for fiscal year 1992-93 is \$121,449.''

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## STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment simplifies the language to accomplish the intent of Committee Amendment "B" and adds a fiscal note to clarify the fiscal impact of the resolution.
