SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "B" to S.P. 42,
L.D. 66, "RESOLUTION, Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution
of Maine to Provide State Funding of any Mandate Imposed on
Municipalities"

Amend the amendment in the first line after the title (page
1, line 17 in amendment) by striking out the word "bill" and
inserting in its place the word 'resolution'

Further amend the amendment in section 21 in the first
paragraph in the 26th line (page 1, line 45 in amendment) by
inserting after the following "municipalities;" the following:
'applies to all persons similarly situated, including the state
and local governments'

Further amend the amendment in section 21 in the first
paragraph by striking out all of the last 5 lines (page 2, lines
1 to 5 in amendment) and inserting in their place the following:
'routine obligations, the combined cost of which in any calendar
year is less than .001 of the total amount of property taxes
collected in the State during the previous year.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment expands the types of mandates that the State
is not required to fund.

This amendment also strikes language that exempts routine
single mandates with a cost of less than \$100,000 per year and
with a combined cost of less than .001 of the amount of property
taxes collected in the previous year and replaces it with
