
SENATE AMENDMENT "C" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "B" to S.P. 42, L.D. '66, "RESOLUTION, Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution of Maine to Provide State Funding of any Mandate Imposed on Municipalities"

Amend the amendment in the first line after the title (page 1, line 17 in amendment) by striking out the word "bill" and inserting in its place the following: 'resolution'

Further amend the amendment in section 21 in the 2nd paragraph in the 3rd line (page 2, line 9 in amendment) by striking out the following: "2/3" and inserting in its place the following: '60%'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment provides that legislation enacted specifically to implement the constitutional amendment may not be amended except by a 60% vote, rather than the 2/3 vote required in the committee amendment.
