Amend the resolution in the 2nd resolve paragraph in the 5th
and 6th lines (page 1, lines 20 and 21 in L.D.) by striking out
the following: "statewide election, at a statewide election, on
the Tuesday following the first Monday of" and inserting in its
place the following: 'general election, at the next general
election in the month of'

This amendment is being presented on behalf of the Committee
on Bills in Second Reading. The amendment corrects the language
setting up the referendum procedure to reflect that this
carry-over bill will go out to a vote at the general election in
November 1992.
