SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 56, L.D. 77, Bill, "An Act to Extend the Commission to Study Maine's Oil Spill Clean-up Preparedness and to Improve Marine Oil Spill Prevention, Planning and Response"

Amend the amendment in section B-13 in the last line by striking out the following: "May 1, 1991." and inserting in its place the following: 'July 1, 1991.'

Amend the amendment by striking out all of the fiscal note and inserting in its place the following:

This bill allocates from the Maine Coastal and Inland Surface Oil Clean-up Fund \$97,070 in fiscal year 1990-91, \$624,818 for fiscal year 1991-92 and \$606,662 for fiscal year 1992-93 to the Department of Environmental Protection, the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife, the Department of Marine Resources and the Department of Conservation to carry out the purposes of this Act. This bill also increases the fee per barrel on unrefined crude oil and other products from 3¢ to 4¢ effective July 1, 1991 and will result in an increase in dedicated revenue to the Maine Coastal and Inland Surface Oil Clean-up Fund of \$1,000,000 for fiscal year 1991-92 and \$1,000,000 for fiscal year 1992-93. There is sufficient revenue

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2 to cover the fiscal year 1990-91 allocation. Also, there is
companion legislation, L.D. 246 "An Act Assuring Clean Waters in
4 Maine" that extends the Commission to Study Maine's Oil Spill
Clean-up Preparedness.'

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
10 The amendment changes the effective date of the fee increase
