An Act to Strengthen the Involuntary Commitment Laws.



Be i	it	enacted	by	the	People	of th	e State	of	Maine	as	follows:
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34-B MRSA §3873 is enacted to read:

§3873. Obsessive behavior

For purposes of this article a person is mentally ill and poses a likelihood of serious harm if that person engages in obsessive behavior that is threatening to another person. A person engages in obsessive behavior that is threatening to another person if that person makes threats to another person of bodily harm to that person or of harm to that person's property at least 4 times in 3 months. A person hospitalized solely as a result of behavior identified in this section may be discharged 14 only if the chief administrative officer of the hospital certifies that the person is no longer likely to engage in obsessive behavior that is threatening to another person.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

22 This bill permits involuntary commitment of a person who engages in obsessive behavior that is threatening to another 24
