**An Act to Require that Handwriting be Taught from Kindergarten to
Grade 6.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

20-A MRSA §4708 is enacted to read:

§4708. Instruction in handwriting

A course in handwriting must be taught in each grade from kindergarten to grade 6, in all schools, both public and private.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill requires that handwriting be taught from kindergarten to grade 6.
