COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 67, L.D. 95, Bill, "An Act Concerning the Licensing of Organizations Operating Games of Chance or Beano"

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the statement of fact and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. 17 MRSA §314, first \P , as amended by PL 1977, c. 696, §365, is further amended to read:

24 The Chief of the State Police may issue licenses to operate "Beano" or "Bingo" games on a monthly basis to any volunteer fire department or any agricultural fair association or bona fide 26 political, nonprofit charitable, educational, 28 recreational, fraternal, religious or veteran's patriotic, veterans' organization which that was in existence at least 2 30 years prior to its application for a license, when sponsored, operated and conducted for the exclusive benefit of such 32 organization by duly authorized members thereof. The Chief of the State Police may also issue a license to any auxiliary associated 34 with an organization, department or association qualified for a license under this section if the auxiliary has been in existence 36 at least 2 years before applying for a license and the games are sponsored, operated and conducted for the exclusive benefit of 38 the auxiliary by duly authorized members of the auxiliary. Proceeds from any game conducted by the auxiliary or the 40 auxiliary's parent organization may not be used to provide salaries, wages or other remuneration to members, officers or employees of the auxiliary or its parent organization. Said The 42 2 years' limitation shall does not apply to any chartered posts of veterans' organizations, nationally established, or 44 auxiliaries of those posts, even though such the posts have not 46 been in existence for 2 years prior to their application for a license nor shall does the 2 years' limitation apply to any 48 volunteer fire department or rescue unit + - and - provided - that -a or auxiliary of that department or unit. A license may be issued to 50 an agricultural fair association when sponsored, operated and

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 67, L.D. 95

Sec. 2. 17 MRSA §314, 2nd ¶, as amended by PL 1987, c. 197, §2, is further amended to read:

The fee for such a license to any nonprofit organization is \$5 for each calendar week, or portion thereof, that the amusement is to be operated, or the license may be issued for a calendar month for a fee of \$15. All license fees shall must be paid to the Treasurer of State to be credited to the General Fund. lieenses-may-be A license is not assignable or transferable. Nothing contained in this section is-to may be construed to prohibit any volunteer fire department or any agricultural fair association or bona fide nonprofit charitable, educational, political, civic, recreational, fraternal, patriotic, religious ex, veterans' organization or auxiliary of any of them from obtaining licenses for a period not to exceed 6 months on one application. No more than one license may be issued to any organization for any one period. No more than one licensee may operate or conduct a game of "beano" or "bingo" on the same premises on the same date.

This legislation is expected to have a minimal impact on the license sales and enforcement duties of the Department of Public Safety, Licensing Division, Beano - Games of Chance.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

30 The original bill permitted veterans' auxiliaries to obtain Beano licenses. The amendment broadens the category organizations eligible for a license to operate Beano or Bingo 32 games by permitting an auxiliary of any qualified organization to 34 obtain a license in its own name. The auxiliary would be required to meet all the qualifications required of other organizations, including the requirement of 2 years' existence 36 and the requirement that the games be operated for the exclusive 38 benefit of the auxiliary. The 2-year limitation would not apply to veterans' auxiliaries or auxiliaries of volunteer fire 40 departments or rescue units. The amendment also provides that proceeds of games conducted by the auxiliary may not be used to 42 provide salaries or other remuneration for the auxiliary or the parent organization.
