Resolved: That the Director of the 22 Bureau of Public Lands shall convey to James R. Daigle, Jr. the State's interest in a certain parcel of land in Rumford. The 24 State's interest must be conveyed for the amount of \$250 to cover the costs associated with transfer of title. Transfer documents 26 must be prepared by James R. Daigle, Jr. for review and approval by the bureau. The parcel of land is described as follows: 28 A certain lot or parcel of land situated in said Rumford and 30 being Lot No, 28 on High Street as shown on Map No. 24 on file in the office of the Assessors, Rumford, Maine. 32 FISCAL NOTE 34 1991-92 **REVENUES** 36 38 Other Funds \$250 40 The conveyance of a parcel of land in Rumford will increase dedicated revenue to the Department of Conservation, Bureau of 42 Public Lands by \$250 for fiscal year 1991-92. This revenue will result from the department charging for the administrative costs 44 associated with the conveyance.'

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COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 68, L.D. 96

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STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment deletes reference to the "State's initial investment" and replaces it with language which indicates that the amount of \$250 to be paid by James R. Daigle, Jr. is solely to cover costs associated with the title transfer.
