COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 68, L.D. 96, "Resolve, Authorizing the State to Release Its Interest in Certain Real Property in Rumford, Maine"

Amend the resolve by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the statement of fact and inserting in its place the following:

'Authority to convey. Resolved: That the Director of the Bureau of Public Lands shall convey to James R. Daigle, Jr. the State's interest in a certain parcel of land in Rumford. The State's interest must be conveyed for the amount of \$250 to cover the costs associated with transfer of title. Transfer documents must be prepared by James R. Daigle, Jr. for review and approval by the bureau. The parcel of land is described as follows:

A certain lot or parcel of land situated in said Rumford and being Lot No. 28 on High Street as shown on Map No. 24 on file in the office of the Assessors, Rumford, Maine.

The conveyance of a parcel of land in Rumford will increase dedicated revenue to the Department of Conservation, Bureau of Public Lands by \$250 for fiscal year 1991-92. This revenue will result from the department charging for the administrative costs associated with the conveyance.'

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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6 This amendment deletes reference to the "State's initial
investment" and replaces it with language which indicates that
8 the amount of \$250 to be paid by James R. Daigle, Jr. is solely
to cover costs associated with the title transfer.
