IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND NINETY

An Act to Dispense with Final Hearings in Uncontested Divorces or Modifications to Decrees.



	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	10 NADEA \$219
4	19 MRSA §318, as enacted by PL 1989, c. 834, Pt. A, is amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read:
6	If the court or hearing officer is satisfied that the amount
	of child support stipulated by the parties is in substantial
8	compliance with the presumptive application of the guidelines and
	that no other matter is at issue in the divorce, the court may
10	enter an order that effectuates the stipulation without holding a
	final hearing.
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	This bill provides that a final hearing in an uncontested
18	divorce case need not be held if the parties stipulate child
	support in an amount that substantially complies with the child
20	support guidelines.
