An Act to Authorize the Issuance of State Identification Cards to People Under the Age of 21.

1-A. Under 21 years of age. The Secretary of State may issue an official state nondriver identification card to a person 15 years of age or older and under 21 years of age. The card must be a color that is easily distinguishable from the identification card issued to a person 21 years of age or older.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill permits the Secretary of State to issue official state nondriver identification cards to persons 15 years of age or older and under 21 years of age similar to those cards currently issued to persons 21 years of age or older. Cards for persons under 21 years of age must be a color that is easily distinguishable from the cards issued to persons 21 years of age or older.
