IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD
NINETEEN HUNDRED AND NINETY-ONE

An Act to Require the State to Pay Medicare Costs for Retired State Employees and Retired Teachers.



Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §285, sub-§11 is enacted to read:

11. Supplemental coverage; Medicare-eligible retirees. For those retirees who are eligible for coverage under this section, and who are also eligible for Medicare, the Maine State Retirement System shall pay 100% of only the retirees' share of the premiums for Medicare Part B.

Sec. 2. 20-A MRSA §13451, sub-§6 is enacted to read:

6. Supplemental coverage; Medicare-eligible retired teachers. For those retired teachers who are eligible for coverage under this section, and who are also eligible for Medicare, the Maine State Retirement System shall pay 100% of only the retirees' share of the premiums for Medicare Part B.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill requires the Maine State Retirement System to pay Medicare Part B premiums for state retirees and retired teachers.
