30	STATEMENT OF FACT
32	The original bill altered the existing law so that the
34	special archery season began 30 days prior to and extended to the beginning of the regular deer hunting season. This amendment
36	requires that the commissioner establish by rule a special archery season beginning at least 30 days prior to the regular
38 .	season and extending to the beginning of the regular season. This amendment is designed to ensure that the opening of the
10	special season for archery is not delayed past the existing October 1st opening date on those years when 30 days prior to the
12	regular season falls on a date later than October 1st.
